### **Meet The Horses!**

#### **Shes All Made Up-** Riverside Ranch and Cassandra Letts (Withdrawn)

A double registered AQHA/ARHA Bay Red Roan mare by Machine Made out of KM Best In The Rain (Rhapsody In The Rain). This mare won the 2021 NSBA/EMO 2-year-old futurity with Ty Elrod and has withdrawn due to being shown prior to the Masters. She is owned and bred by Riverside Ranch, Letts, McCraw

#### **Righteous Brother** – Norm Williamson

Jordan Aikens works at Stacey Kleikamp Quarter horse in Yamhill, Oregon. When not riding and training Jordan spends time with his family, hiking and fishing. Stacey bred and raised “Garth” at her facility until owner Norm Williamson bought him as a yearling. Jordan started Garth and has done all of the preparation on this Masters entry. Garth is out of “Always At The Bar” and is by “Righteous Invitation”. Norm resides in California and also has a 3-year-old and a weanling.

Tonight Kyler Nall will present Garth. Jordan is home recovering from an illness. Kyler has been riding with Stacey for several years. He is a recent High School graduate from McMinnville Oregon. Kyles desire is to be a Profession trainer.

#### **iLOPE-** Christina Meng

A Western National Champion In Hand Trail, Res Nat'l Ch yearling LL, APHA World Championship show Top 5 and Top 10 in both Yearling LL and In-Hand Trail. I LOPE is sired by iSTYLE, who is by the great RL Best Of Sudden and out of a full sister to Dress Western. iLOPEs dam is Lopin Lucille, multiple world and res world champion. Lopin Lucille is the only horse in APHA history to show in all four open legs of the breeders futurities at the APHA World Show (weanling halter, yearling LL and in hand trail, 2 yr WP, and 3 yr WP). Mark and Meaghan Gilmore raised iLOPE's dam, and showed her throughout her entire career, including placing 3rd in the Emerald Masters Futurity her 2-year-old year. iLOPE is proudly bred and owned by Christine Meng of Hidden Creek Farms in Arlington Washington.

#### **WillUBMyValentine-** Jeff Williams

WillYouBeMyValentine is a two-year-old sorrel AQHA gelding sired by former Emerald Masters winner My Sleepy Valentine and out of I Will Be Invited by Good I Will Be. Bred by Cathy Guest of Alberta, Canada. Kristy McCann and her husband Dean McCann train western all around and reined cow horses at family-owned Summitview Ranch in Graham Washington. Kristy is one of the top trainers of Western Riding horses in the United States. Since 1989 Kristy and her customers have earned multiple AQHA World Show Championships and Reserve World Championships in Western Riding on horses such as Cosmic Sunstone, Sudden Inclination, Biznessly Inclined, Ima Struttin Machine, Kickn Axe in Levis, The Uninvited Guest and Sucha Machine to name a few. Kristy has also coached numerous youth and amateur riders to World Titles and top ten's at the AQHA World Championships.

#### **Willy Willy Cute-**Randi Johnson and Kathy Brumfield

“Willy Willy Cute” also known in the barn as Jolene. Jolene is sired by the infamous Winnies Willy and out of a Certain Potential Dam. Jolene is an example of the great breeding program by Debbie Trubee at North Farm. Kip Larson is catch riding for Ty Elrods training program. Since 1991, Kip Larson has been skillfully training horses and preparing clients to successfully compete in all-around events. With countless World Titles to the Larson Performance Horses name, including the eight World Championships, seven Reserve World Championships, and two World Champion All-Around Titles earned in 2014 alone, it's clear to see

that Kip Larson and his team have developed an incredibly effective program in the Pacific Northwest. Co-owned by Mother & Daughter: Kathleen Brumfield and Randi Johnson.

### **Somethins Gota Give- Nathan SiJohn**

Alex Whalen was born and raised in Trabuco Canyon, California, where he grew up on a ranch and his life revolved around horses. Beginning his training career in his teens, Alex has worked for numerous world class trainers throughout the years on the way to becoming a professional. He has achieved many circuit championships, World & Reserve World Championship Titles, Top 5's, and Top 10's, and top 3 at the Quarter Horse Congress for both himself and his customers on the AQHA, APHA, and PtHA show circuits. Alex prides himself on the professional presentation of his horses and riders in and out of the show arena. We are excited to present Somethins Gota Give, owned by Nathan SiJohn, in the 2021 Northwest Emerald Masters 2 year old Western Pleasure. Somethins Gota Give is a 2 year old stallion sired by Lazy Loper, out of Her Last Good Rose by Good Version. This young stallion has all the attributes and potential to make a great Western Pleasure horse. Nathan is very excited about his future as a show horse and breeding stallion.

### **Makin Slow Moves- Karen Kelly**

"Makin Slow Moves" also known around the barn as "Cody" is out of the leading western pleasure sire, who needs no introduction, Machine Made, and out of an Only In The Moonlight dam whom also competed in the NW Emerald Masters herself as a 2 year old. Cody is owned and bred by Karen Kelly and Jana Vaagen of JK Kelly Quarter Horses. Ty Elrod started Ty Elrod Equine Services in 2014 with a passion and expertise in futurity and all around youth, amateur, and open horses. With a goal in turning out well rounded horses and crafting capable riders, Ty has found much success in the show pen, including but not limited to; numerous top five placings at the AQHYA Youth World Championships, Lucas Oil AQHA World Championships, and the All American Quarter Horse Congress. His customers have also achieved All Around Championships at major circuits including Arizona Sun Circuit and Silver Dollar Circuit. Ty himself is a multiple futurity champion, winning the NW Emerald Masters in 2018 and most recently unanimously winning the 2 year old open western pleasure futurity at the EMO Western States Championships this past July.

### **Martinis On The Bay- Ginger Leeper**

Gingers passion is developing 2 and 3 year old prospects. She takes pride in creating horses that are not only successful in many events but also enjoyable inside and outside of the arena. Ginger and her husband own a beautiful new facility that they built from the ground up in Bellingham, Washington. Twenty six years of showing and owning horses brings her to a training program that boast wins for her customers in all around events as well as a Year End PTHA Novice Youth English Pleasure Horse of the Year with a ten year old exhibitor.
